Course Overview

The Standard 11 Surface Coal Mine Safety Skill Set is mandatory for workers entering or operating on a surface coal mine site in Queensland. This nationally recognised program provides foundational knowledge and practical safety skills to ensure compliance with mining safety legislation and site procedures.

This training includes six core units of competency focused on workplace communication, emergency response, risk control, and compliance with WHS and site procedures.

Training is delivered through a combination of face-to-face theory, practical activities, and supervised assessment.

Upon successful completion, participants will receive a Statement of Attainment recognised across the Queensland mining sector.

Entry Requirements

To enrol, participants must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Possess or apply for a USI (Unique Student Identifier) – [Apply here](#)
- Provide three (3) forms of valid ID (see next section for details)
- Wear closed-in footwear, long-sleeve shirt, and long pants
- Successfully complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment

Learning Outcomes

Participants will gain skills and knowledge to:

- Apply WHS protocols and comply with mine site safety procedures
- Communicate effectively with team members and supervisors
- Conduct risk assessments and implement control measures
- Respond to emergencies and on-site incidents
- Understand roles within Safety and Health Management Systems (SHMS)
- Provide initial first aid response in workplace emergencies

Assessment & Certification

Assessment includes:

- Written knowledge test
- Practical tasks under trainer supervision

On successful completion of all assessment tasks, learners will receive a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment for all six units in RIIS00034 – Surface Coal Mine Safety Skill Set.

Resources & Delivery Method

Participants receive a **comprehensive Learner Guide**

Training is conducted through a mix of **classroom-based theory and practical hands-on exercises**

Practical sessions are held in a **simulated or real working environment**, supervised by qualified trainers

Evidence of Identity

At least one category A document must be photographic and show a full name and date of birth (DOB)

A candidate must produce, and an assessor must sight, three matching, original, evidence of identity (EOI) documents before undertaking an assessment or reassessment.

The EOI documents must comprise either:

- One (1) Category A document and two (2) Category B documents, or
- Two (2) Category A documents and one (1) Category B document.
- The category A document must show your full name and date of birth. **Certified photocopies will not be accepted.**
- All documents must be current unless otherwise stated.
- At least one Category A document must be photographic and show a candidate's full name.
- At least one Category A or B document must show the candidate's signature and date of birth.
