Course Overview

This 1-day, competency-based training program equips participants with the essential skills and knowledge required to safely operate and maintain a four-wheel drive (4WD) vehicle in off-road and workplace conditions. It is specifically tailored for workers in the resources, infrastructure, and related industries, where the ability to use a 4WD is critical for safety and mobility.

Training includes a mix of classroom instruction and hands-on, practical experience in real-world terrain, allowing participants to build confidence while managing challenging driving environments.

This course is ideal for:

- Workers in mining, exploration, forestry, construction, and emergency services
- Employees who need to drive 4WD vehicles in rugged, off-road, or remote environments
- Site-based personnel requiring evidence of 4WD competency for employer or site access

Entry Requirements

To enrol, participants must:

- Be 17 years of age or older
- Have or obtain a USI (Unique Student Identifier) Apply here if you don't already have one
- Provide three (3) valid forms of ID (see Student Handbook for details)
- Be physically fit and capable of operating a vehicle in rough terrain
- Wear appropriate PPE:
- Closed-in footwear

Must also complete a brief LLN (Language, Literacy and Numeracy) quiz prior to course commencement.

Learning Outcomes

Participants will develop the ability to:

- Perform pre-departure checks, including fluid levels, tyre pressure, recovery equipment, and safety items
- Understand key **4WD terminology**, systems, and settings
- Safely engage four-wheel drive mode and drive in varying terrains (mud, gravel, inclines, water crossings, etc.)
- Perform basic maintenance and complete minor repairs when operating in remote areas
- Conduct a safe vehicle recovery, including the use of snatch straps, winches, and recovery boards

Evidence of Identity

At least one category A document must be photographic and show a full name and date of birth (DOB)

A candidate must produce, and an assessor must sight, three matching, original, evidence of identity (EOI) documents before undertaking an assessment or reassessment.

The EOI documents must comprise either:

- One (1) Category A document and two (2) Category B documents, or
- Two (2) Category A documents and one (1) Category B document.
- The category A document must show your full name and date of birth. Certified photocopies will not be accepted.
- All documents must be current unless otherwise stated.
- At least one Category A document must be photographic and show a candidate's full name.
- At least one Category A or B document must show the candidate's signature and date of birth.
