Course Overview

Theory components are completed at our **Toll Street office**, while the **practical training and assessment** take place at our **Bluewater training farm**.

These units are ideal for:

- Individuals entering the civil construction or agriculture industries
- Workers seeking formal recognition of existing skills
- Employers upskilling staff for on-site requirements
- Participants pursuing plant competency for licensing or employment purposes

Entry Requirements

To enrol in any machinery unit, participants must:

- Be 16 years of age or older
- Possess or apply for a **USI (Unique Student Identifier)** Apply here
- Provide three (3) forms of valid ID (see final page for accepted types)
- Wear **closed-in footwear** for all practical sessions
- Successfully complete a short Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) quiz

Pre-requisites: None

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

If you have previous experience operating the machinery you wish to be assessed in, you may be eligible for **RPL** to shorten your training time. Evidence such as:

- Workplace logbooks
- Photographic/video evidence
- Supervisor or employer references
- Prior training certificates

...may be considered as part of the assessment.

Please note:

Overseas licences and non-accredited training cannot be accepted as direct RPL, but they may be used to support your case.

All students must complete both theory and practical assessment to be deemed competent.

Evidence of Identity

At least one category A document must be photographic and show a full name and date of birth (DOB)

A candidate must produce, and an assessor must sight, three matching, original, evidence of identity (EOI) documents before undertaking an assessment or reassessment.

The EOI documents must comprise either:

- One (1) Category A document and two (2) Category B documents, or
- Two (2) Category A documents and one (1) Category B document.
- The category A document must show your full name and date of birth. Certified photocopies will not be accepted.
- All documents must be current unless otherwise stated.

At least one Category A document must be photographic and show a candidate's full name. At least one Category A or B document must show the candidate's signature and date of birth.
