

RIIHAN301E Operate elevating work platform (UNDER 11 METRES)

Course Overview

This one-day nationally recognised course provides participants with the essential knowledge and practical skills to safely operate **elevating work platforms (EWPs) under 11 metres**, including **scissor lifts**, **boom lifts**, **vertical lifts**, and **trailer-mounted lifts** (SL, BL, TL, VL).

This unit does **not require a High Risk Work Licence (HRWL)** and is suitable for those working at heights of less than 11 metres in a wide range of industries such as construction, maintenance, warehousing, and landscaping.

This course is suitable for:

- General construction and maintenance workers
- Warehouse and logistics personnel
- Facility and grounds maintenance crews
- Landscapers, cleaners, and signage installers
- · Anyone operating scissor or boom lifts under 11 metres

If your duties require you to operate a boom-type EWP **over 11 metres**, you must complete the **TLILIC0005 – Licence to Operate a Boom-Type EWP (Boom Length >11m)** 3-day course.

Entry Requirements

To enrol, participants must:

- Be 17 years of age or older
- Possess or apply for a **USI (Unique Student Identifier)** Apply here
- Provide three (3) forms of valid ID (see final page for details)
- Wear closed-in footwear (preferably steel-capped), long-sleeve shirt, and long pants
- Successfully complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment

Pre-requisites: None

Assessment & Certification

This course includes:

- Work planning and site assessment
- Routine inspection and fault detection
- Safe operation procedures
- Emergency controls and hazard awareness
- Shut down and post-operation tasks

Hands-on training is provided using actual **scissor lifts** and **boom-type EWPs** under 11 metres in a controlled environment.

Assessment includes:

- Written and verbal knowledge questions
- Practical demonstration of safe operation
- Trainer observation and feedback

Upon successful completion, learners will be awarded:

A Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment and wallet sized card for:

RIIHAN301E - Operate Elevating Work Platform

This card is often accepted on worksites as evidence of formal EWP training for machines under 11 metres.

Evidence of Identity

At least one category A document must be photographic and show a full name and date of birth (DOB)

A candidate must produce, and an assessor must sight, three matching, original, evidence of identity (EOI) documents before undertaking an assessment or reassessment.

The EOI documents must comprise either:

- One (1) Category A document and two (2) Category B documents, or
- Two (2) Category A documents and one (1) Category B document.
- The category A document must show your full name and date of birth. Certified photocopies will not be accepted.
- All documents must be current unless otherwise stated.
- At least one Category A document must be photographic and show a candidate's full name.
- At least one Category A or B document must show the candidate's signature and date of birth.
