Course Overview

This competency-based one-day course provides the knowledge and practical skills required to **safely operate, maintain, and shift loads using a vehicle loading crane**. Designed for workers in **site-based roles**, this unit is delivered in alignment with **national operational standards**, but **does not provide a High Risk Work Licence**.

It is ideal for workplaces or roles where vehicle loading cranes are used with **lower risk profiles**, or where licensing is not required under current jurisdictional regulations.

Training is delivered via a combination of **classroom theory** and **practical supervised activities**, either at **Industry Training QLD's facility** or on-site (by arrangement).

NOTE

While this unit includes practical, hands-on crane operation, it **does not** result in a High Risk Work Licence.

If you require a High Risk Work Licence (e.g. **TLILIC0024 – Licence to Operate a Vehicle Loading Crane [10 metre tonnes and above]**), please contact us. We offer this unit as well and can assist with enrolment.

This unit is suitable for:

- Workers operating vehicle-mounted cranes in **controlled, low-risk environments**
- Site-based personnel who **shift loads as part of routine operations**
- Employees who require formal training for **internal workplace compliance**
- Those **not requiring a high-risk work licence**, but needing validated operating skills

Entry Requirements

To enrol, participants must:

- Be **18 years of age or older**
- Have or apply for a **USI (Unique Student Identifier)** – [Apply here](#)
- Provide **three (3) forms of valid ID** (refer to final page for accepted document types)
- Wear **closed-in footwear** and bring **protective gloves**
- Successfully complete a **Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment**

Pre-requisites: None

Learning Outcomes

On successful completion, participants will be able to:

- **Plan and prepare** for crane operations in line with job instructions and safety procedures
- **Operate vehicle loading cranes** safely and effectively to move and position loads
- Apply routine **maintenance and shutdown procedures**
- Complete **housekeeping tasks** and finalise job records as required

Certification

Participants who successfully complete all training and assessment components will be issued with a:

RIIHAN307E – Operate a Vehicle Loading Crane**

This statement serves as formal evidence of training but does **not authorise high-risk crane operation under licenced conditions**.

Evidence of Identity

At least one category A document must be photographic and show a full name and date of birth (DOB)

A candidate must produce, and an assessor must sight, three matching, original, evidence of identity (EOI) documents before undertaking an assessment or reassessment.

The EOI documents must comprise either:

- One (1) Category A document and two (2) Category B documents, or
- Two (2) Category A documents and one (1) Category B document.
- The category A document must show your full name and date of birth. **Certified photocopies will not be accepted.**
- All documents must be current unless otherwise stated.
- At least one Category A document must be photographic and show a candidate's full name.
- At least one Category A or B document must show the candidate's signature and date of birth.
