Course Overview

This unit of competency provides learners with the necessary skills and knowledge to safely and effectively operate a **forklift truck** in accordance with workplace procedures and relevant legislative and licensing requirements.

Training includes **theory lessons**, **instructional videos**, and **hands-on practical operation** of a forklift in both indoor and outdoor environments. Upon successful completion, students will be eligible to apply for a **High Risk Work Licence (LF)** through WorkSafe.

 \nearrow Please note: Completion of the unit alone does not authorise operation until a High Risk Work Licence is issued by the regulator.

Entry Requirements

To enrol in this course, participants must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have a valid USI (Unique Student Identifier) Apply here
- Provide three (3) original ID documents (refer to the Student Handbook for EOI guidelines)
- Wear closed-in steel-capped boots, long pants, and a long-sleeve shirt
- Successfully complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) quiz

Pre-requisites: None

Learning Outcomes

On completion of this unit, participants will be able to:

- Determine **load weight**, size, and characteristics
- Safely operate a forklift truck, including to maximum height and load capacity
- Identify, assess, and control hazards and risks
- Interpret load data plates and equipment specifications
- Use site communication systems to interact with team members
- Perform routine checks and inspections of forklift equipment

Assessment & Certification

Assessment includes:

- Written knowledge test
- Verbal questioning
- Practical skills demonstration using a forklift truck

Successful participants will be awarded:

A Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment for:

TLILIC0003 - Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck

 An Interim High Risk Work Licence, valid for 60 days, allowing the student to operate a forklift while awaiting their official licence from WorkSafe

↑ The High-Risk Work Licence (LF class) must be renewed every 5 years.

Resources & Delivery Method

Participants are provided with a Learner Guide and supporting handouts

Training includes multi-media classroom materials

Delivery is face-to-face and includes both indoor theory and outdoor practical components

Training is led by experienced and qualified instructors

Evidence of Identity

At least one category A document must be photographic and show a full name and date of birth (DOB)

A candidate must produce, and an assessor must sight, three matching, original, evidence of identity (EOI) documents before undertaking an assessment or reassessment.

The EOI documents must comprise either:

- One (1) Category A document and two (2) Category B documents, or
- Two (2) Category A documents and one (1) Category B document.
- The category A document must show your full name and date of birth. Certified photocopies will not be accepted.
- All documents must be current unless otherwise stated.
- At least one Category A document must be photographic and show a candidate's full name.
- At least one Category A or B document must show the candidate's signature and date of birth.
